EDUCATION OPTIONS

- AA – CBC offers a two-year Associate of Arts & Science degree with an emphasis in Agri-Business.
- Transfer – Students who graduate with an AA in Agri-Business will meet the requirements for the first two years of a bachelor degree at most four-year institutions. Courses are designed to assure transferability to regional universities, meeting specific requirements for degree options in agricultural business and natural resource sciences.
- AAS – CBC offers a two-year Associate of Applied Science in Agriculture and Industrial Equipment Technology degree to prepare students to become technicians for agriculture and construction equipment dealers.



WHAT INTERESTS YOU?

A career in agriculture can vary from research and development, manufacturing, and production, to education, economics, and public relations. Here are just a few examples of agriculture careers:

- **BUSINESS/SALES** – Analyze, assess, and manage the purchasing and finances for an agriculture-related business. Negotiate contracts, coordinate with brokers, and control inventory. Ensure your company meets or exceeds revenue goals by conducting domestic and foreign sales.
- **LOAN OFFICER** – Specialize in land financing of farms, timber and forestry operations, agribusiness, recreational land, and other rural property.
- **ENGINEER** – Design agricultural machinery, equipment, and structures to improve the processing of agricultural products.
- **MARKETING/PR** – Develop relationships and enhance company image and public awareness through public relations and marketing efforts for an agriculture-related business.
- **INSPECTOR** – Ensure compliance with state and federal laws and regulations governing the health, quality, and safety of agricultural products. According to data from CareerBuilder.com, Agricultural Inspectors are ranked sixth in the nation for having the fastest growing salaries.
